The company is located in South Florida and Saint Bernadette will be their first fair in Ohio. Their selection includes t-shirts, posters and holy reminders.

There are books in many different genres including fiction and nonfiction.

Liz was born in Queens, N.Y. Her parents left Cuba in 1961 in search of freedom. She was raised in South Florida and has worked as both a journalist and an author of a historical fiction novel for young adults. Her book, Mission Libertad, is a story about a young boy's dangerous escape from Cuba. She is a member of St. Mark parish in Southwest Ranches, Florida. She comments that, "Teachers and principals from all over the country have reached out to us searching for an alternative to secular book fairs. They want their students to develop both academically and spiritually. We are here to fill that need! We sell books that are true to our Catholic faith and values."
