OPEN HOUSE- MEET THE TEACHER- An open house is being planned to Sunday afternoon, August 19. More details to follow...

FIRST DAY OF SCHOOL FOR 2018-19 (for grades 1-5) will be **Wednesday, August 22**. Students in Kindergarten and Preschool will have a staggered entrance. Mrs. Utz (P) and Mrs. Elder (K) will offer orientation conferences during the first couple days of school. Watch your August mail for more kindergarten and preschool news, and a conference schedule.

ARRIVAL AND DEPARTURE- School begins at 7:50AM for grades K-5. Please be sure your child is here at that time. Students should arrive **NO EARLIER** than 7:35AM. There is no supervision of students before this time. Students arriving before a teacher is on duty will be sent to our morning-care program, and parents will be assessed the fee.

In the mornings, if the weather is fair, a teacher will have the children outside. When you arrive for morning drop-off, enter at the top drive way, and continue around, following either the yellow safety rope or the cones (one or the other will be in place.) Children should exit your car on the passenger side, into the "safe zone". If your child requires help getting out of the car, please park and walk him/her to the "safe zone." The children are **NOT** to go inside without the duty teacher's permission. Do not drop off near the church doors, as that backs up traffic onto Wheeling Road. **DO NOT PARK IN THE FIRE LANE.**

School ends at 2:35 PM. Please make arrangements to have your child picked up at that time. Anytime your child's transportation or pick-up plans change, please send a note. If the child will be riding the bus some days and riding home others, please send in a note detailing the schedule. Children riding the bus home, line up at the doors near Wheeling Road. **DO NOT BLOCK THE BUSES.** Children walking and riding in cars will be released from the Parish Hall doors (closest to the playground). A teacher must release them before they can leave the line. For early release (for doctor or dentist appointments), sign children out at the office and send a note to the teacher. **IF THERE IS ANYONE WITH WHOM YOUR CHILD MAY NOT RIDE, PLEASE NOTIFY THE SCHOOL IN WRITING!**

Preschool sessions are 8:30 am-11:00 am, and 12:00 pm to 2:30 pm. Students should be dropped off at the classroom door. Morning students will be dismissed at the front entry of the school. Afternoon students will be dismissed through the parish hall doors.

EXTENDED DAY PROGRAM (EDP) St. Bernadette offers morning care from 6:30am to 7:35am, and afternoon care from 2:35 to 5:30pm. Registration for EDP opens July 1st. The EDP handbook and registration forms are available at our website (www.stbernadetteschool.com). To register, please complete both sides of the registration form and return it with your registration fee. If you think your family will use the extended day program at any time during the school year, we ask that you register before Aug 12.

ADDRESSES & PHONE NUMBERS of our students and their families are published annually in the St. Bernadette Home and School Student Directory. These directories are only distributed to school families. In addition, other sub-committees of the Home and School Association sometimes use class lists to track fundraisers and other business. **If you do not want your address and phone number to be published** or given to St. Bernadette organizations, please call the school office (740-654-3137).

BUS INFO:

► Bus schedules are printed in the Eagle Gazette before school starts. For questions, or to be sure your child is on the bus list, call the Bus Barn at 740-687-7366. Also, alert the bus barn if your child is picked up or dropped off at a sitter's house rather than your residence. Please be aware that the first few days of school, the schedule is a little slow. If your child will be going home with a friend, please send a written note so the staff can be sure the child gets on the right bus.

► Lancaster City Schools adheres to an established policy that they do not transport daycare students, or students residing in another district.

STUDENT SAFETY – Outside doors of our building are locked during school hours. Visitors are asked to enter at the front entry and press the buzzer for admittance. All visitors to our building will be required to sign-in upon arrival and sign-out as they leave. During their stay, visitors will be asked to wear a visitors' badge. The Visitors' Log is in the school office.

SNOW DAYS AND EMERGENCY DAYS OFF will be announced via an automated phone call (please see Emergency Communication below). If Lancaster City Schools cancels classes, St. Bernadette will be closed. The three Lancaster Catholic Schools may cancel classes independently of Lancaster City. The "greeting" on the school answering machine will also announce any schedule changes.

EMERGENCY COMMUNICATION via *School Messenger* - Our students' emergency phone numbers will be entered into this emergency contact system. Please make sure the school has your correct contact information.

UNIFORMS - St. Bernadette students in grades **K-5** are required to wear approved uniform attire. Uniforms are available at the following:

Please note however, girls' plaid uniform jumpers and skorts, and yellow uniform shirts must be purchased from one of the uniform stores listed above. The navy blue skirts found in department stores are NOT our uniform.
- St. Bernadette Home and School Association will offer an apparel sale in the Fall. Uniform sweatshirts and polo shirts will be sold. School T-shirts (which can be worn w/ uniform pants on *Tuesdays*) and school jackets will also be sold.
- *St. Bernadette Uniform Exchange* will be set up in the school hallway in August. Feel free to drop off the gently used uniform garments that your child has outgrown, and pick up the next size for your child. Help yourself to any/all items that your family needs, even if you don't have clothing to donate.

LITURGIES – All students in grades K-5 will attend morning Mass weekly. Whole-school Masses will also be held at 8:20AM on Holy Days and other Feast Days. Whole-school Devotionals will be planned throughout the school year, and will be announced in the weekly newsletter. Parents are welcomed and encouraged to attend all our liturgies and devotionals.

CAFETERIA: Hot lunches will be available beginning the first day of school. The menus for the first week of school will be Cooks' Choice. **Lunch prices** for 2018-19 will be \$2.75 and include milk or bottled water. Pre-paid lunch stamps can be purchased in advance every Monday morning (or the first day of the school week). **Pre-paid lunch stamps are the suggested means.** It is easier for students to buy with a stamp, and the lunch line goes much faster. Stamps are not dated and can be used for any school lunch, any time during the current school year. **Lunch Prices: 1 stamp-\$2.75, 2 stamps-\$5.50, 3 stamps-\$8.25, etc.** For those students who pack their lunch, milk (white and chocolate), and bottled water is available for 50¢ a ½ pint. Please do not pack pop as a beverage. Monthly menus will be posted on the school's website.

FOOD ALLERGY NOTE: Several of our students suffer from nut/peanut allergies. In an effort to keep all our students safe, we are a peanut-aware school. Our school cafeteria does not serve nut or peanut products, and we ask all parents, whenever possible, to send peanut-free lunches and snacks to school.

Cafeteria Volunteers Needed:
