

What is SCRIP?

Scrip fundraising is a no-selling program that allows families to earn money toward your tuition expenses and support Home & School at the same time! Scrip is just another way to pay for everyday purchases using gift cards in place of cash, checks, and credit cards.

How does SCRIP work?

You purchase gift cards from your organization at face value, and your coordinator orders those cards at a reduced price. The difference is money for your organization. It's really that simple!

Where can I use Scrip gift cards?

When you use Scrip gift cards at your favorite retailers, you're fundraising while you shop. We offer over 300 of the country's biggest brands, including grocery, department stores, gas stations, restaurants, hotels, home improvement, and more. Just by using scrip to pay for your normal weekly purchases, you can easily raise \$500 or more per year. It's time to put your shopping dollars to work!





How do I sign up?

Fill out a Scrip Registration form and return to the school office c/o Scrip Coordinators. Then go to <u>shopwithscrip.com</u> and register for an account. St. Bernadette School's enrollment code is **AFALDCA82228**.

How do I order and receive Scrip?

The easiest method is ordering online at <u>shopwithscrip.com</u>. You may also use our paper order form. We process orders on Tuesdays and Thursdays. You may receive your order by picking it up at school or having it delivered home via kidmail.

How do I get the most out of Scrip?

Take advantage of the online ordering using PrestoPay (checking account payment), the mobile ScripWallet, ScripNow, Reload, and ReloadNow.
