St. Bernadette Soccer Field Rules As Of: August 25, 2021

- 1. The Parish does not have any sort of scheduling or reservation system for the soccer field. It is strictly on a first-come/first-serve basis, and open to the general public.
 - a. If more than 1 group shows up on a given day / time to use the field, the Parish will not intervene to determine who may use it.
- 2. Anyone that uses the field does so at their own risk, as the Parish does not maintain the field other than cutting the grass.
 - a. The liability for any type of injuries that might happen to players and/or spectators while using the field would be borne by the group using the field.
- 3. The Parish does not supply any equipment for the use of the field.
- 4. There are no public restroom facilities.
- 5. There will be no access to any of the St. Bernadette campus buildings, including the school, the church, the rectory, the parish hall, and the business office.
- 6. If the Parish needs the field for a Parish-related event on any given date, the Parish would be under no obligation to allow anyone else to use the field at the same time.
 - a. The Parish would also be under no obligation to communicate to anyone who wishes to use the field on the same date.
- 7. Any group who uses the field must clean up and remove all trash from the field after the event has concluded.
- 8. Since the field is part of the St. Bernadette Catholic Parish campus, the following behaviors are strictly prohibited by both players and spectators:
 - a. Obscene language
 - b. Bullying, fighting, and other aggressive behaviors
 - c. Alcohol consumption and the use of illegal drugs
 - d. Smoking of any kind
 - e. Carrying a loaded weapon of any kind
 - f. A violation of any of these rules of behavior will result in the group being prohibited from using the field in the future.
